**Prior to arrival, confirm the cut-off times to Camps at the relevant entrance gates to ensure arrival at destination before Camp Gate closing time!**  
**Visitors must take note of the above gate times and also plan the travelling time between Park and Camp gates!**

Late arrivals are allowed for guests with pre-booked accommodation until 21:00 at an extra cost of R150.00 per vehicle, and only through the following gates if arranged in advance with the first camp booked:

GATE	REST CAMP
Crocodile Bridge:	Only for guests with a valid reservation in Crocodile Bridge
Malelane:	Only for guests with valid reservations in Malelane /Berg-en-Dal
Numbi:	Only for guests with a valid reservation in Pretoriuskop
Kruger:	Only for guests with a valid reservation in Skukuza
Orpen:	Only for guests with a valid reservation in Orpen, Maroela or Tamboti (Not Satara)
Punda Maria:	Only for guests with a valid reservation in Punda Maria

Under no circumstances are late arrivals allowed at Pafuri, Phalaborwa or Phabeni Gates

Please refer to Internet/Reservation Office or Park for further details. Please take note that the maximum speed limit is 50 km/h for tar roads and 40 km/h for gravel roads. Should visitors not arrive on the arrival date of the reservation, the accommodation will be held until 09:00 the following day, after which the reservation will be cancelled and the deposit, where applicable, forfeited.

**CHECK-IN TIME FOR ACCOMMODATION IS FROM 12:00 AND ACCOMMODATION MUST PLEASE BE VACATED BY 09:00**





**MALELANE CAMP** residents must check in at **Malelane Gate** and not at the camp.

**BALULE CAMP** residents can check in at any of the larger camps (preferably Satara or Olifants Camp).

**TAMBOTI and MAROELA CAMP** residents must check in at Orpen Camp.

**TSENDZE CAMP** residents must check in at Mopani

	Visitors should consult a knowledgeable medical practitioner about recommended medication. Highest risk in high rainfall season (Dec – Apr). A 24-hour malaria hotline is available on 082-234-1800
	With the exception of Crocodile Bridge, Orpen and the bush lodges and bush camps, all camps have restaurants.
	All camps except bush lodges and bush camps have grocery and curio shops. Shop size and extent of stock is relative to size of camp.

	There are 7 Wilderness trails in the park. See website – booking through reservations. Guided day walks are available from most camps. Pre-book through reservations or consult camp on arrival.
	Day and Night drives are available from all the camps. Pre-book through reservations. <b>Warm clothes required for night drives.</b> Bush braais and bush breakfasts are now available at selected camps.
	The campsite tariff includes the first two persons, one caravan with a side tent and one vehicle, or a maximum of two tents and one vehicle, or one auto villa, or one motorised caravan will be permitted per site. Additional persons (up to a maximum of four) as well as additional vehicles will be subject to additional payment in terms of the tariffs applicable at the time.
	Only Skukuza has a bank, but there is also an ATM at Letaba Rest Camp. Some of the camp shops also have mini ATM's available.

**Recommended Routes from Gauteng:**

- Southern Gates      N4 Toll Road (Gauteng – Witbank – Nelspruit – Hazyview / Malelane / Komatipoort) ± 4 – 5 hrs  
Alternative Route    (Belfast - R540 - Lydenburg - R37 - Sabie R536 Hazyview) ± 5 hrs
- Central Gates        (Gauteng - N1 Toll Road Polokwane - R71 Tzaneen - Phalaborwa) ± 5 hrs
- Northern Gates      (Gauteng – N1 Toll Road Polokwane - R81 – Giyani – Punda Maria) ± 5.5 hrs

Travelers should consult national road atlases (AA & Total maps recommended) for greater detail and for alternate routes to avoid tollgates.
